2. HIGHLIGHT REPORT

ADVISE	The Occupational Health Manager informed the LPF that the TUPE Transfer of Bridgend Occupational Health Staff into CTMUHB was being progressed, with a transfer date of the 1 April 2021.
ASSURE	<p>The Nurse Director of Bridgend Integrated Locality Group (ILG) provided an update in respect of the work that has been undertaken by Child & Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS), against the Action Plan, over the past 6 months, in response to being placed in Internal Enhanced Monitoring and Support Measures for a one year period. It was reported that very positive progress is being made with the support of Workforce and Organisational Development (OD) and Wellbeing colleagues.</p> <p>The Senior Responsible Officer (SRO) for the Community Vaccination Centre Programme of work reported that this programme of work was going well and CTMUHB was achieving the Welsh Government vaccination target dates for the current priority groups.</p>
INFORM	<p>The LPF was provided with an update on the Health Board's Staff Survey results. The presentation outlined how this data would be used to improve the employee experience moving forward.</p> <p>The LPF was provided with an update on the progress being made to embed the new CTMUHB values and behaviours. It was confirmed that the OD Team will be running a number of virtual Teams Values and Behaviours Workshops for all staff, commencing towards the end of March 2021.</p>
