2. HIGHLIGHT REPORT

ALERT / ESCALATE	No items to alert or escalate to the Board.
ADVISE	<p>The Executive Director for People advised the LPF on the Welsh Government proposal, in respect of Targeted Additional Activity Payments. It was agreed that the LPF would be engaged on determining on it would be implemented within CTM and provide final sign off of the proposal.</p> <p>The Assistant Director of Policy, Governance and Compliance set out the work being undertaken by CTM to embed a just and learning culture. It was confirmed that this work will be rebranded as a listen, learn and improvement culture, to fit with the CTM values. The Workforce & Organisational Development (WOD) function confirmed that it would collaborate with others across the Health Board, such as Quality and Safety colleagues, to ensure a consistent approach and use of language to assist to embed this culture.</p>
ASSURE	<p>The Assistant Director of Policy, Governance and Compliance delivered a presentation on the Community Vaccination Centre (CVC) Workforce and Pipeline Plan, which includes fixed term employees, Local Authority and Fire Service Mutual Aid deployed staff, bank workers and volunteers. The presentation outlined the actual staff in post figures against budgeted roles and confirmed how dedicated Bank CVC workers and ongoing recruitment campaigns are helping to fill vacancies.</p> <p>The Director of Public Health also delivered a presentation to provide assurances that the CTM COVID-19 vaccination Programme is delivering against the delivery plan.</p>
INFORM	<p>CTM had retained the Gold Corporate Health Standard Award in June 2021. It was confirmed the Health Board would be assessed, in respect of the Platinum Corporate Health Standard Award, during November 2021</p> <p>Verbal updates were provided on the Prince Charles Hospital Improvement Work Project and Maternity Services.</p>
