1. SITUATION/BACKGROUND

This report presents the Annual report and Accounts of the Cwm Taf Morgannwg NHS General Charitable Fund for approval.

The registered charity "Cwm Taf Morgannwg NHS General Charitable Fund" requires annual accounts and an annual report to be prepared and submitted to the Charity Commission prior to the 31 January 2021.



The Board act as Trustees to this fund, and this report is therefore presented in this capacity.

The format of the Accounts has remained unchanged from last year.

2. SPECIFIC MATTERS FOR CONSIDERATION BY THIS MEETING (ASSESSMENT)

Annual accounts and an annual report for the period 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020 have been prepared by Cwm Taf Morgannwg UHB and then audited by Audit Wales. These are attached to this report as Appendix 1.

Cwm Taf Morgannwg Letter of Representation by management is attached as Appendix 2.

The previous years' accounts, which were well below the audit threshold, were subject to an independent review rather than the full audit. Due to the transfer of Bridgend charitable funds from 1 April 2019, the monetary size of the charitable funds have increased and therefore the accounts for 2019-20 have been subject to a full audit process by Audit Wales.

An unqualified opinion is being proposed and the auditor's proposed report is attached as Appendix 1.

Once the accounts are approved and signed by the Trustees, these will be shared with Audit Wales for the Auditor General for Wales' certification.

3. KEY RISKS/MATTERS FOR ESCALATION TO BOARD/COMMITTEE

As noted within section 2 of the report above, the charitable fund accounts for 2019-20 have been subject to a full audit instead of an independent review in the previous years. Due to the full audit and the increased time arising from the audit matters, the audit fee for 2019-20 has increased from $\pounds 2k$ in the previous year to $\pounds 38k$ for 2019-20.

The Health Board has agreed to meet the extra cost of the audit fee exclusively for 2019-20. There will be an increased audit cost in future years, but to lesser extent than in 2019-20, and this will need to be met by the charity.
