Climate Change Risk Assessment	The PSB has set up three senior manager Task and finish groups on three of the priorities – Climate Resilient Communities, Infrastructure Pinch points and Post Industrial Landscape lead by PSB members who will feedback on progress to each PSB. Each organisation is nominating appropriate senior managers to each of these groups. A self reflection exercise for each organisation on the PSB is bring together current and planning work on climate risk. The existing task group is being refocused to external and inter- and cross-organisation communication. Workforce Well-being Sub-board	A google space to connect staff with volunteering opportunities in green spaces has been completed and shared. The Neurodivergence task group have prepared an advice sheet for managers and are working with the regional partnership on an event on Neurodivergence and work.	Green
Active Travel Charter	The charter was signed launched at the PSB in July. <a href="https://www.sustrans.org/">Sustrans</a> is helping organisations complete a review of current work to feedback into the network.	Green
Young Voices Project	The children and young people’s engagement network met for the 3 <sup>rd</sup> time in September. Through an open agenda identified 3 topics for discussion and action - out of area placements for children who are looked after and the impact of new leg and potential shortfall of foster carers, understanding democracy for young people alongside social media and other influences, current forums mapping for children and young people. Work continues on reverse mentoring programme and the website as a portal for sharing engagement plans and results.	Green

Data Dashboard and Website	The final dashboard has been completed and will be uploaded onto PSB website shortly.
